All About Animals

Read p.34-55

Vocabulary:

1. **mammal**---an animal with a backbone that usually has hair or fur on its body and feeds milk to its young.
2. **bird**---an animal with a backbone that has feathers, two legs and wings.
3. **fish**---an animal with a backbone that lives in the water and has gills.
4. **reptile**---an animal with a backbone that has dry scaly skin.
5. **amphibian**---an animal with a backbone that lives part of its life on land and part of life in the water.
6. **insect**---an animal without bones that has three body parts and six legs.
7. **gills**---special body parts that get oxygen from the water.
8. **camouflage**---a color or shape that makes an animal hard to see.
 - A mule deer's fur changes color in the summer and winter. p. 42
 - A penguin's second layer of feathers helps it to keep warm. p. 45
 - Fish have fins to help them swim. p. 46
 - Catfish use their feelers to find food in the dark. p. 47
 - A desert iguana's light color keeps it from getting too hot. p. 49
 - A frog's smooth, wet skin helps it live in moist environments. p. 50
